

Remarks, Terms & Conditions of Yes! Kids Can Creative Festival and its Activities

I. Exhibition and Interactive Area

- 1. The opening hours of the exhibition and interactive area are from 11am to 7pm.
- 2. Certain areas will not be open to non-participants until completion of certain special activities, if any, in the interactive area.
- 3. Parents are advised to take care of their participating children and their personal belongings, since the organiser PMQ will only notify the Police of and not be liable for any damage and loss of personal property.
- 4. All facilities in the exhibition and interactive area are for public enjoyment. PMQ reserve their rights to indemnify the user(s) who cause(s) the damage, if any.
- 5. Tours are available for specific times and areas during the exhibition period. Please refer to the on-site notice for further details.
- 6. Please refer to Part III for any inclement weather arrangement.
- 7. In the event of any dispute, the decision of PMQ shall be final.

II. Talk, Workshops and All Other Activities

All participants are required to read the following remarks, terms and conditions before enrolment, and considered to have full understanding of and be in agreement with such remarks, terms and conditions upon completion of enrolment.

> Enrolment and Fees

- 1. Some of the activities require online enrolment and deposits, the full deposit shall be refunded upon completion of the programme by cash on the event day. Seats are limited and first come first served. Enrolment without complete information and/or without full payment will not be considered. At-the-door enrolment are allowed while the quota have not been filled.
- 2. A confirmation notice will be sent to the registered email account upon successful enrolment and payment. For those who fail to receive the notice, please contact PMQ by email at marketing@pmq.org.hk or by phone at +852 5224 2215.
- 3. Any change of classes, dates and timeslots upon completion of enrolment will not be entertained. The fees paid by the successful enrollees who eventually fail to attend the activities in whatever reasons will neither be refunded by PMQ nor be accepted for any other purposes.
- 4. Participants are advised to report presence with their respective confirmation notice emails for verification purpose at least 10 minutes before the activities.
- 5. Parents are advised to be aware of various age requirements of different activities of the participants. PMQ reserves its right to verify the identity and the age of the participant, and any age discrepancy might cause disqualification without refunds.
- 6. Successful enrollees will receive full refund within 1 month in the event of cancellation due to under-enrollment of the paid activities.
- 7. PMQ reserves its right to change the timetables of the activities. Participants (Or parents and guardians of enrolled children) will be notified in advance, and those who do not accept the new arrangement will receive a refund of the relevant payment within 1 month of completion of the activities.
- 8. Once the application process is completed, all personal data of both successful and unsuccessful applicants will be kept in the database of PMQ Management Co. Ltd. For



- statistical analysis, the contact information of all participants will be included in the mailing list of PMQ Management Co. Ltd for news updates unless otherwise stated.

Participants and applicants agree that PMQ takes ownership of all photographs and films it takes or on its behalf, and the photographs and films can be used in any function for publicity use.

> General Arrangement, Absence and Late Arrival

- 1. Participating adults are required to ensure both they and the participating children are physically fit and safe for the activities. Rest is advised for any discomfort. PMQ and the tutors of the activities will only be responsible to notify the Police for any accidental incidents.
- 2. PMQ reserves its right to change the content or choice of tutors and / or speakers of any activities, or to arrange substitutes for indisposed tutors without further notice.
- 3. Participants are required to inform PMQ of any absence in any activities. Absentees are considered to forfeit their participation. PMQ reserves its right to reallocate such quota to other interested parties.
- 4. PMQ reserves its right to terminate the participation of late arrivals of more than 15 minutes without class changes or refunds.
- 5. PMQ reserves its right to terminate the participation of the vandals who fail to follow the instructions of the tutors and the ground crew and thus influencing the normal operation of the activities without class changes or refunds.

- 7. In the event of any dispute, the decision of PMQ shall be final.

When the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is no longer in force or the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal has been changed to No.3 or below before 9am, the Exhibition and Interactive Area will remain open. When the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is no longer in force or the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal has been changed to No.3 or below between 9am and 1pm, Exhibition and Interactive Area will reopen in 2 hours.
Talk or Sharing Session:	 When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or below, or the Amber / Red Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force, the Talk or Sharing Session will continue. When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued 2 hours before and in force during the Talk or Sharing Session, it will be cancelled. When the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is no longer in force or the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal has been changed to No.3 or below 2 hours before the Talk or Sharing Session time, it will continue. When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued during the Talk hours, the Talk or Sharing Session might continue or be cancelled. All visitors and participants are suggested to stay in safe areas or to leave under safe circumstances.
Workshop:	 When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.1 or the Amber Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force, the activities will continue. When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or above, or the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued or still in force 2 hours before the activities, the activities will be cancelled. When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal has been changed to No.1 or the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is no longer in force 2 hours before the activities, the activities will continue. When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or above, or the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal



is issued during the hours of the activities, the
activities might continue or be cancelled. All visitors
and participants are suggested to stay in safe areas or
to leave under safe circumstances.

- 1. In inclement weather conditions and for safety reasons, PMQ reserves its rights of final arbitration on the cancellation or rearrangement of the entire event and its activities.
- 2. Deposits will be refunded to the participants for the activities that are cancelled due to the inclement weather.
- 3. If circumstances allow, PMQ might try to arrange make-up activities for the cancelled ones at the time designated by PMQ.
